



GETTING TO 272

Gunnersbury Avenue is part of the North Circular, and our building is located close to the Chiswick Roundabout where the North Circular meets the A4.

...BY CAR

Navigation via Waze: If you navigate to 270 Gunnersbury Avenue (instead of 272), this will bring you directly to the front of the building and the gate leading to the car park.

What3Words: The [what3words](#) app will bring you directly to the front of our building, use: **dose.slap.lazy**

NOTE: If you are travelling on the Great West Road from the south-east and from Heathrow, you need to continue to the Chiswick Roundabout, essentially passing 272, and loop round the back of our building via the A315 and Power Road. This will avoid you having to make a U-turn on Gunnersbury, which can add up to 20 minutes to your trip.

GOOD TO KNOW: The Chiswick High Road and Power Road are both Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ) areas. Please check if your car is compliant. You can do that [here](#) or [here](#).

...BY TUBE & TRAIN



There are a number of overground- and underground-serviced stations within walking distance of our offices. The closest are **Gunnersbury** (0.4 miles) and **Kew Bridge** (0.4 miles). Further away are **Acton Town** (0.8 miles) and **Chiswick Park** (0.8 miles). Depending on where you are coming from, you might use an underground train (Tube) or an overground train, or even a combination of both.



Gunnersbury is on the Richmond branch of the District Line and Overground. Kew Bridge is a mainline rail station on the line linking Hounslow to Clapham Junction and Waterloo. Acton Town is on the Piccadilly and District lines. Chiswick Park is on the Ealing Broadway branch of the District line.

NOTE: If you are travelling to the Gunnersbury station, remember that you need to check your train is on the **Richmond branch** of the District line and Overground to avoid landing up in Clapham Junction.

GOOD TO KNOW: As well as Google Maps, useful public transport apps you can use include [Citymapper](#), [National Rail](#) and [Transport for London \(TFL\)](#).

...BY BUS



There are multiple bus routes running along Chiswick High Road – from Hammersmith in one direction, and Brentford, Hounslow and Kew in the other.

Bus routes with nearby stops: H91, 237, 267, 110, 440, N9. A short (10-15 min) walk away: E3, 65, N65, N11.

...BY BIKE



There are bike racks available at 272 within the covered car park. There are also changing rooms with showers and lockers, situated on the ground floor.
